What is a vehicle immobiliser?


A vehicle immobiliser is a security device designed to prevent the unauthorised use of a vehicle. It achieves this by disabling essential vehicle components, such as the starter motor, fuel and ignition system, rendering the vehicle inoperable without the correct authentication.

How does it work?

Modern immobilisers typically use one of the following methods to control access:

- Automatic Driver Recognition (ADR): This
 method requires the driver to authenticate their
 identity using an app, card, or code before
 starting the vehicle.
- Passive Systems: These systems automatically activate when the vehicle is stationary, often using RFID technology to detect a key fob or tag.
